



Hall of Fame Nominations

1. The LIJSL Hall of Fame Committee are accepting nominations for induction onto the LIJSL Hall of Fame 2009. Nominations must be typed in triplicate and received by LIJSL Hall of Fame, 101 Sunnyside Blvd., Suite 555, Plainview NY 11803, no later than **November 7, 2008**. Nominations must include a biography of the candidates contribution to youth soccer.
2. Induction into the Hall of Fame will honor those individuals who have made significant voluntary contributions to the development of youth soccer in the Long Island Junior Soccer League.
3. Candidates may be nominated by any member club in good standing, or by any individual who is a member of the league in good standing. LIJSL Board members cannot nominate active fellow Board members.
4. Candidates must be members of the league in good standing. they must have at least twelve (12) years of exceptional service to the youth of the Long Island Junior Soccer League with three (3) years of direct service to the league. (i.e. club president, registrar, LIJSL committee member). The individual nominated should have provided exceptional service in the promotion of youth soccer.
5. . Candidates names previously submitted for consideration will be kept in our files for two (2) years and will be activated accordingly. After the two (2) year period a candidate must be resubmitted for consideration.
6. The committee will accept all nominations, review them thoroughly, and make the final selection of no more than three.

Veteran's Hall of Fame Nominations

The LIJSL Hall of Fame Committee are accepting nominations for induction onto the LIJSL Veteran's Hall of Fame 2009. Nominations must be typed in triplicate and received by LIJSL Hall of Fame, 101 Sunnyside Blvd., Suite 555, Plainview NY 11803, no later than **November 7, 2008**. Nominations should include a biography of the candidates contribution to youth soccer.

The committee for the LIJSL Hall of Fame will elect members to the LIJSL Veteran's Hall of Fame, using the following guidelines:

1. Candidates to the Veteran's Hall of Fame, who have made long-term and significant positive contributions to youth soccer at various levels on Long Island who have been overlooked or bypassed for Hall of Fame election by the regular selection process and who are in good standing in their community.
2. Candidate can no any longer be eligible for selection by regular selection committee (i.e. never nominated, presently out of the youth soccer limelight, and therefore not likely to be nominated).
3. Active in youth soccer on Long Island for a minimum of 12 years.
4. Maximum of three individuals to be elected by committee in any single year.
5. Award to be presented to those selected under Veteran's guidelines concurrently with presentation of award to regularly elected members of the Hall of Fame each year.
7. Nominations to be made by any member club, by any individual involved with any member club, by any member of the LIJSL Board of Directors, or by any Hall of Fame member.
