The Coaches must agree to either have the game played or reschedule the Game. Team Must Play Match and 5 Rule will be Enforced.





BAD WEATHER or POOR FIELD CONDITIONS PROCEDURE

Bad Weather and/or Poor Field Conditions a) Inspection of Playing Site It shall be the home team Adult Supervisors or the Club's designated governing authority's responsibility to inspect the game field prior to the match. In the event of bad weather, the Home Team Adult Supervisor, after inspection of the field, must notify the League Contact no later than 2 hours prior to the scheduled starting time of the match that field conditions may require postponement of the match. b) Both Teams Must Appear Should any part of the two (2) hour notification period lapse, regardless of weather and/or field conditions, Adult Supervisors and their teams must appear at the match (game) site, ready to play at the scheduled time of the match, or the match will be forfeit. Once any part of the two (2) hour notification period has lapsed, the Referee is the only person authorized to cancel the match. In the event that weather and/or field conditions are questionable for playing the match and the Referee fails to appear, the decision to play or cancel is granted to the Home team.

FORFEITS

Teams that Forfeit a Game Within 48 Hours of a Match Will Incur a Fine and Be Responsible to Pay the FULL Referee Fees.

REFEREE ABUSE PREVENTION

PENALTY SUMMARY

POLICY 531-9 / YOUTH & AMATEUR SOCCER

LEVEL 1: VERBAL TAUNTING

Speech or gestures intended to belittle the referee, damage their credibility, and undermine their ability to effectively officiate the game.

DEFINITION

Insulting, Belittling, Insinuating or Taunting Behavior Undermining Referee Authority.

EXAMPLES

- Questioning Competence:
- "Do you even know the rules?"
- Mocking Appearance or Abilities:
- "Did you forget your glasses?"
- Accusations of Bias:
 - "What's the other team paying you?"
- Dismissive Language:
- "You suck."
- Aggressive Tone:
- "You're the worst ref we've ever had."

RECOMMENDED APPROACH

If you have concerns about a call, respectfully ask the referee for clarification. Share your perspective calmly, avoiding yelling, insults, or offensive gestures.





- Penalties for spectators' misconduct towards a referee
- If it is determined that spectators violated the ENYYSA Zero Tolerance policy with respect to misconduct towards a referee or match official, the following minimum fines to the team's club.



Official	1st offense by team during seasonal year	2nd offense by team during seasonal year	3rd offense by team during seasonal year
Adult Referee	\$250	\$500	\$1000 + ENYYSA Supervisory Hearing
Minor Referee	\$750	\$1500	\$3000 + ENYYSA Supervisory Hearing

AED MANDATE for Youth Sports in **New York** State

- New York State Public Health Law (PHL) Section 3000-F requires all regulated children's camps and youth sports programs to provide an automated external defibrillator (AED) or describe reasonable access to an AED at the camp. Additionally, the legislation requires each camp to:
